- All programs include a full tour of the Museum from costumed guides if applicable to the program
- Two Museum staff will be on hand during program, however we ask that you have the minimum of 5:1 children to adult ratio
- All three houses at the OCM are accessible
- Service animals with identification are welcome

1) Early Lighting + Candle Making

Explore early lighting, from candles to oil lamps. Learn about candle making and take home your very own candle!

2) Toys and Games

How did Victorian children play with toys? What kind of games were used? Get an opportunity to interact with Victorian Toys and get a chance to make one that you can take home and play with.

3) Archaeology Night

Learn all about the exciting field of Archaeology. Participate in a mock excavation and create a clay pinch pot.
